Our Favourites

BACCHUS, GIFFORDS HALL, 2019 – SUFFOLK, UK

This wine is produced in a small and local Suffolk vineyard, we are proud to offer this excellent example of English wine making.

The Bacchus is a favourite due to its dry, yet fruity punch

RED BOAR BOBAL, BODEGAS GALLEGAS, 2018 – ATLANTIC, SPAIN

This youthful grape with its deep red fruit and nutmeg spice is soft, medium bodied and well balanced. A lesser-known varietal coming out of Spain, we love this wine for its versatility and vibrancy

Sparkling

Prosecco NV Stelle d'Italia

A lively, crisp Prosecco, with a delicate lemon character and hints of fresh green pears on the palate

Perrier Jouet NV Grand Brut

The palate is impetuous yet full, with a cheerful vitality due to its persistent stream of sprightly bubbles

Intense, luminous salmon pink with coppery highlights and a steady stream of fine bubbles, the crunchy red fruit and citrus flavours show a delicate balance and great length

Magnificent greenish gold in colour, the palate confirms the complexity and richness of the bouquet with an initial lively freshness leading into a rounded palate

Hambleton

Hambleton is one of the oldest vineyards in England, starting in 1952. From the long line of heritage to the chalky sub-strata of the South Downs, Hambleton excel in making premium wine's directly comparable to that of Champagne

Hambleton Classic Cuvee Brut

Floral and stone fruit aromas; a vivid wine, well-structured with ripe acidity and a lasting finish

The palate is rich, flavours of strawberry balanced by zingy cranberry with a smooth and creamy texture

Aromatic and fresh with hints of apricot and peach. Nicely balanced, with good length and texture

Hand Harvested from Casablanca valley, this wine delivers fresh fruitiness with a long-lasting finish

Red Boar Bobal, Bodegas Gallegas, 2018 – Atlantic, Spain

On the palate it is soft, silky and well-balanced with ripe fruit and pleasant herbal notes

Cuma Organic Malbec, El Esteco, 2019 - Salta, Argentina

Made with organically grown grapes, this savoury red wine is a thrilling mix of dark, brooding fruit and fragrant with punchy spice

Estate Pinot Noir, Humberto Canale, 2018 – Patagonia, Argentina

Notes of spice, candied fruits and fresh red berries. Oak aged for a smoky vanilla aroma

Merlot, Vinamar, 2019 - Casablanca Valley, Chile

Intense aromas of blackberry and plum. Medium body with soft tannins and a round finish

Douro Red, Quinta Do Crasto, 2018 – Douro, Portugal

Expressive aromas, notes of fresh red fruit and violets. Flavours of ripe berries and spices

La Lande, Cinsault Rose, Vin de France, 2019 - South West France

Dry and delicate rose from Languedoc, dry and refreshing from a renowned wine maker

Giffords Hall Rose, 2019 – Suffolk, UK

Aromas of freshly picked strawberries, cherry blossom and a citrus twist in its finish. This delicate local rose offers subtlety in both its pale salmon colour and appealing nose

Rose Sicilia DOC, Planeta, 2019 – Menfi, Italy

Lots of red berry fruit subtle scent of roses and a fresh, lively finish

An elegant and silky, dry rose. Fresh, flavours of white fruit and a hint of spice

Vinho Verde, Quinta da Lixa, 2019 – Vinho Verde, Portugal

Fresh floral notes followed by a smooth palate of peach with a substantial finish

Land Made Sauvignon Blanc, Yealands, 2020 - Marlborough, New Zealand

Notes of guava and stone fruits bursting with flavour but delivering a crisp, mineral finish

Albarino, Eidosela, 2018 - Rias Baixas, Spain

Wonderfully aromatic, exhibiting a freshness with hints of apricot and peach. Nicely balanced, with a good length and texture on the palate

Viognier Pays d'Oc, Leduc, 2019 - Languedoc, France

A vibrant, luminous colour with green hues. On the nose, peach, apricot and almond aromas prevail with a refreshing yet fruity palate with a smooth and round finish

Picpoul de Pinet, Reserve Roquemoliere, 2019 – Languedoc, France

Crystal clear wine with light green hints, soft nose with a zesty palate

Pinot Blanc, Trimbach, 2018- Alsace, France

Completely dry, with a good structure and lots of breadth. Lemony fruit with mineral undertones

Douro White, Quinta Do Crasto, 2018 – Douro, Portugal

Fresh citrus and tropical fruit aromas, delicate orange blossom notes with a marked minerality

Marama Sauvignon Blanc, Seresin, 2015 – Nelson, New Zealand

Organic grapes barrel fermented, for a rich texture. Elderflower and citrus aromas with a hint of honeycomb. Complex and involving with soft oak and a lingering finish

Pinot Grigio Arcole, Sartori, 2019 – Veneto, Italy

White pears and flowery notes on the nose, soft and fresh on the palate

Alvarinho Pouco Comum, Quinta Da Lixa, 2019 – Minho, Portugal

Notes of peach, lemon and grapefruit with floral tones and a full texture on the palate

Chardonnay, Vinamar, 2018 - Casablanca Valley, Chile

Hand Harvested from Casablanca valley, this wine delivers fresh fruitiness with a long-lasting finish

Petit Chenin, Ken Forrester Wines, 2019 - Western Cape, South Africa

A youthful fresh wine with quince and pear drops flavours. Real freshness on the palate with crunchy green apple and grapefruit

Gewurztraminer, Trimbach, 2016 – Alsace, France

Full, balanced and very aromatic. Aromas of lychee, rose, ginger and geranium. Exotic and spicy

Touraine- Oisly, Domaine de Pierre, 2018 – Loire, France

A somewhat new vineyard producing the “classic” sauvignon grapes, acidic, fresh and dry

Columbia Valley Chardonnay, Chateau Ste. Michelle, 2018 – Washington, USA

Fresh, soft style with bright apple and sweet citrus fruit and a subtle nuance of oak

IGP Principaute d’Orange Viognier, Domaine de la Janasse, 2018 – Rhone, France

Notes of peach, apricot and white flowers emerge from this medium-bodied, round, textured and balanced Viognier

Chablis, Joseph Drouhin, 2019 – Burgundy, France

Typical of a Chablis, with aromas of citrus and fern. Very mineral in character. Well balanced and elegant

Red Wines

Carignan/Grenache Vin de France, La Lande, 2018 - South West France

Deep garnet in colour with a spicy ripe nose; the palate is rich with ripe fruit character

St Edmundsbury Pinot Noir, Giffords Hall, 2018 – Suffolk, UK

Named in honour of Bury St Edmunds, the vineyard, and our local town. Generous on the nose, packed with fruit flavours such as plum, rhubarb and cranberry

Merlot, Vinamar, 2019 - Casablanca Valley, Chile

Red ruby colour with light purple hues, intense aroma of blackberry and plum. Medium body, soft tannins and a round finish

Cuma Organic Malbec, El Esteco, 2019 – Salta, Argetina

Made with organically grown grapes, brooding fruit with a fragrant punchy spice

Rioja Crianza, Ramon Bilbao, 2017 – Rioja, Spain

Medium intensity of aromas with fresh dark fruit, such as blackberries and blackcurrants

Estate Pinot Noir, Humberto Canale, 2018 – Patagonia, Argentina

Notes of spice, candied fruits and fresh red berries. Oak aged for a smoky vanilla aroma

L'Étoile de Villegeorge, Château Villegeorge, 2018 – Bordeaux, France

Dark, deep red colour. Nose is expressive of berries and flowers. Soft, well-rounded on the palate, with power and velvety ripe tannins

Douro Red, Quinta Do Crasto, 2018 – Douro, Portugal

Expressive aromas, notes of fresh red fruit and violets. Flavours of ripe berries and spices

Montepulciano d'Abruzzo DOC Anfora Organic, Francesco Cirelli, 2017 – Abruzzo, Italy

Vastly different from the traditional Montepulciano d'Abruzzo. Notes of bright red plums, blackberry and thyme dominate this delicate, light and fresh wine

Barolo di Serralunga d'Alba DOCG, Fontanafredda, 2014 - Serralunga d'Alba, Italy

Characterised by great structure and power. Dry and tannic, but with velvety texture and great balance. Notes of vanilla, spices and underbush. Long lasting finish

Plumbago Nero d'Avola Sicilia DOC, Planeta, 2018 – Sicily, Italy

Plumbago is dominated by aromas of ripe plums and wild blackberries with hints of incense, jasmine and black truffle

Red Boar Bobal, Bodegas Gallegas, 2018 – Atlantic, Spain

On the palate it is soft, silky and well-balanced with ripe fruit and pleasant herbal notes

Malbec Gran Reserva, Vina Falernia, 2015 - Elqui Valley, Chile

Aromas of rose petal, violet and white pepper. Bright palate and spiced game finish

Columbia Valey Syrah, Chateau Ste. Michelle, 2017 – Washington, USA

The fruit is harvested from the Wahluke Slope vineyards, a site with ideal growing conditions for traditional Rhône varieties giving a fruit-forward style, robust blackcurrant and plum flavours and soft, silky tannins

Bourgogne Pinot Noir, Joseph Drouhin, 2018 – Burgundy, France

Aromas of raspberry, red currant and wild strawberry. Pleasant, fruity and refreshing on the palate

Artemis Cabernet Sauvignon, Stags Leap, 2017 - Napa Valley, USA

Stag's Leap Wine Cellars is considered a Napa Valley First Growth, making world renowned Cabernet Sauvignon from its historic vineyards. Inviting aromas of black cherry and plum with hints of vanilla, followed by a smooth, creamy palate of satin tannins and flavours of ripe mixed berries and blackcurrant

Dessert Wine

Akashi-Tai Shiraume Ginjo Umeshu Sake, 2018 - Akashi, Japan

Notes of guava and stone fruits bursting with flavour but delivering a crisp, mineral finish

Late Harvest Tokaji Katinka, Patricius, 2018 – Tokaj, Hungary

Indulgent and complex, the palate bursting with dried apricot, cinnamon and honey

(100ml Glass - £15 375ml Bottle - £40)

Vidal Ice Wine, Peller, 2017 – Ontario, Canada

Multi-award winning rich, medium to full bodied dessert wine with dominant flavours of honey, golden pineapple, brown sugar and butter. Delicate gold colour with an aromatic bouquet of lemon marmalade, caramelised oranges, pineapple and a touch of honey

Port

NV Finest Reserve Ruby Port, Quinta do Crasto, Douro

Vibrant ruby colour, complex aromas of red berry and balsamic. Elegant with a fresh and lingering finish

Fonseca 10yo Tawny Port, Douro

The bouquet is a complex marriage of ripe, plummy, mature fruit, warm spicy overtones of cinnamon and butterscotch and subtle oak nuances
